The Embassy of India to Lithuania will host an exhibition of paintings and photographs titled "*India's History in Architecture – Monuments and Churches of India*" at the Fresco Hall of the Town Hall, Vilnius from 9th to 12th November 2022. The exhibition is being held to launch the celebration of 75 years of India's Independence in Lithuania. H.E. Mr. Simonas Kairys, Hon'ble Minister of Culture of Lithuania, has kindly consented to inaugurate this exhibition on 8th November 2022.




Curated by the Indian Council for Cultural Relations, this exhibition comprises 24 paintings of selected Indian monuments from the ancient period to modern times by Kashinath Das, an eminent Indian artist and of 24 photographs of selected churches of Goa by Benoy Behl, a well-known photographer, documentary film maker and art historian. UNESCO World Heritage Sites, such as the Ellora Caves, Konark Sun Temple, Khajuraho temples, Buland Darwaza (Fatehpur Sikri) and Red Fort at Delhi that showcase the excellence and diversity of Indian architecture, feature in this unique collection. The photographs of the churches reflect the fidelity of the people of Goa to their Christian heritage, and are also a testament to the longstanding tradition of peaceful co-existence and tolerance innate to Indian civilization.
