Press Release: Viksit Bharat Run 2025 in Warsaw

The Embassy of India organized the Viksit Bharat Run 2025 on 27 September 2025 in Warsaw to motivate the Indian diaspora to contribute towards building a self-reliant and Viksit Bharat i.e. a Developed India. More than 170 members of the Indian diaspora and 12 Polish influencers and sports persons participated in the Warsaw edition of the Viksit Bharat Run 2025.

The 3-km long Viksit Bharat Run commenced on a bright, sunny morning from the Aleje Ujazdowskie, an important arterial road of the Capital City on which the Belvedere Palace, the official residence of the President of Poland and the Chancellery of the Prime Minister of Poland are located. Thereafter, the participants went along the Agrykola adjacent to the prestigious Royal Lazienki Park in sylvan green surroundings that offered a beautiful sight of the Palace on the Isle within the Park, turning into Swolezerow and Kawalerii streets, which constitute part of the diplomatic enclave hosting the premises of several diplomatic Missions. The VBR concluded at the premises of the Embassy of India, Warsaw.

In her address, Ambassador recalled that Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had outlined his vision for a Viksit Bharat 2047 in his 2025 Independence Day speech, emphasizing that India's progress is built on self-reliance, innovation, and citizen empowerment. She detailed further the aspirations all Indians have for Viksit Bharat. Thereafter, she administered the Viksit Bharat pledge to the Indian nationals present and asked them to commit themselves to contribute towards a developed and self-reliant India.

4. Ambassador appreciated the presence of the members of the Polish Kabaddi Federation including their President and Captains of the Men's and Women's Polish Kabaddi Teams. She noted that the presence of Polish friends and sports persons symbolized the robust people-to-people links between both countries.
