**International Seminar in Nalanda University titled**  
**“India on the World Stage: Soft Power, Policy & Youth Diplomacy”**  
**(March 26–28, 2026)**

- Role of youth in humanitarian and environmental diplomacy
- Heritage, Conservation & Cultural Corridors and Civilization
- Dialogue, Diplomacy and Peace
- Translation and Narratives; multilingual public diplomacy, literary exchanges, soft power and digital humanities
