

General Information on Travel Requirements

From India to Poland

Under "India Air Travel Bubble"
Passengers can travel to Poland via Paris, Frankfurt and Amsterdam from Indian Airports in Mumbai, Delhi and Bangalore

Make sure to arrive earlier at the airport (4-8 hours) depending, if someone will take a COVID test there)

After reaching Poland from India, there is an obligatory 10 days self-isolation.

After 7 days of self-isolation, you can make a test – if the result comes negative, the isolation is canceled

From Poland to India

Under "India Air Travel Bubble"
Passengers can travel from Poland via Paris, Frankfurt and Amsterdam to Indian Airports in Mumbai, Delhi and Bangalore

Negative report of RT-PCR test done 48/72 Hrs (Depending on the airline) before travel to be uploaded on <https://www.newdelhiairport.in/airsuvidha/a-pho-registration>

RT-PCR Test will be done on arrival at the Airport

If negative, self monitoring for 14 days

If positive, institutional quarantine

Valid health measures and requirements from different airlines

Royal Dutch Airlines

Flights From India

Visa type allowed: Every valid visa (expect tourist) All of the passengers are eligible to pass by the third category mentioned in the rules as residents of other EU/Schengen countries, if the Netherlands is not their final destination/transition to another EU/Schengen country.

Flights to India

Visa type allowed: Every valid visa (expect tourist)
All of the passengers are eligible to travel under three types of categories: permission to travel (employment/business) from EU country, OCI cardholders or dependents/spouses that are foreign EU nationals.

Health Protocols

Both of the flights (from Poland to India and from India to Poland) are transfer flights, the passengers are required to give 1 NAAT (PCR) negative test result issued within 72 hours before arrival in Amsterdam (the digital or analog copy of the test result must be in English). If you are departing from India, you should show printed and signed negative test declaration to show it on the airport in Amsterdam.

Please note that even if you're vaccinated against COVID-19, you still need to bring a negative COVID-19 test result.

Air France

Flights from India

Visa type allowed: Every valid visa (expect tourist).
All of the passengers are eligible to travel under three types of categories: permission to travel from EU country, OCI cardholders or dependents/spouses that are foreign EU nationals.

Flights To India

Visa type allowed: Every valid visa (expect tourist)
All of the passengers are eligible to travel under three types of categories: permission to travel (employment/business) from EU country, OCI cardholders or dependents/spouses that are foreign EU nationals.

Health Protocols

The French authorities require reinforced sanitary measures and testing for passengers that travel to/from India. You are required to present either:

- negative test report from RT-PCR test (72h prior to departure) and negative result of antigen test (24 hours before boarding) or,
- negative test report for RT-PCR (36h prior to departure).

Also it is mandatory to have a valid visa and print out from the Government of France
website: <https://www.interieur.gouv.fr/Actualites/L-actu-du-Ministere/Attestation-de-deplacement-et-de-voyage>.

Upon arrival in France, an antigenic test will be carried out, before leaving the airport/waiting for the transit. The cost of the same to be borne by the passenger.

Lufthansa

Flights From India

Every valid visa (expect tourist) will allow you to travel. All of the passengers are eligible to pass under three categories: diplomats/business, OCI card/valid visa holders and dependents/spouses.

Flights to India

Every valid visa (except tourist) will grant you a pass on the travel. All of the passengers are eligible to travel under three types of categories: permission to travel (employment/business/diplomats), OCI cardholders or valid visa holders.

Health Protocols

The German authorities require you to wear a medical protective mask on their flight to and from Germany. The mask should be either a surgical mask, FFP2 mask or mask with KN95/N95 standard. You are also required to come to the Airport, at least 4 hours before the departure of the flight. The Check-in will be close 90 minutes before departure time. During the boarding, every passenger will have to undergo a thermal screening as a health protocol.

The passengers are required to have one of three proofs (those documents can be in English, French, Spanish, Italian or German):

- Negative test evidence; PCR, LAMP and TMA (72 hours before arrival in Germany) or Antigen test (48 hours before arrival in Germany).
- proof of vaccination – analog or digital proof of vaccination completed more than 14 days ago.
- proof of immunity – analog or digital proof of recovery via PCR/LAMP/TMA test (valid from at least 28 days up to six months);
