## Agricultural Scenario in Jharkhand

### A Snapshot



### Agriculture sector is the priority area for the Government of Jharkhand

- Total geographical area is 79.71 ha, 47.67% area under cultivation, 29.20% under forest cover and Average land holding
  1.58 ha
- Average annual rainfall is 130 cm (almost double of India's annual average)
- Paddy, coarse grains, maize, wheat and pulses and oilseeds are the major crops
- Mango, Banana, Guava, Papaya, Tomato, Chili & other spices are in abundance, state is also rich in minor forest produce
- 13% growth rate of Agriculture & allied sector over the years

### Sustained efforts of the Govt of Jharkhand has yielded encouraging results with

- Milk production: Increased by 17% between 2014-17; current production being 18 Lakh MT
- Egg production: Increased by 8% between FY15-17; current production being 48 Cr.



- Compared to National and International Average, Jharkhand's Agri-Productivity is low.
- Productivity of Pulses in Jharkhand is higher as compared to national average



### Minor Forest Produce (MFP) in Jharkhand Emerging state for promotion of MFP





### **Minor Forest Produce (MFP) varieties**

- 175+ Minor Forest Produce in Jharkhand
- 40% of the Lac in India is produced in Jharkhand
- Government of Jharkhand has a free policy for trade and transportation of MFP (except Kendu leaves)
- Medicinal plants available in abundance Amla, Harra, Bahera, karanj etc.


### **Investment Opportunities**

- Open opportunity for marketing of processed MFPs
- Skill development of the youth for MFP's collection and processing
- Supply of raw material to herbal and Ayurveda industry etc.

C: Potentially useful and only locally used.



## Key Measures by Jharkhand State

### First of its kind in India - Single Window for Farmer



- Jharkhand is the pioneer state in implementing "Single Window System for farmers"
  - ✓ The single window system provides end to end support to farmers of the state including weather forecast, crop insurance, availability of seeds, market linkage etc.
  - ✓ It has receiving wide spread acceptance and applause among farmers of the state

### **Key Policy Interventions**

#### Soil Health card

 Soil cards are issued to farmers that carries cropwise recommendations of nutrients & fertilizers

## Attract Rural Youth in Agriculture (Arya) Scheme

• To promote the green revolution and attract the rural youth in agriculture in the state.

## Single Window Centre (SWC)

 SWC is one stop service centre for all needs of farmers during the entire life cycle of crop

### DOBHA: - Rain Water Harvesting Structure

 Small and marginal farmers gets get subsidy of 90% whereas other farmers will get subsidy of 50%

The demand-supply gap is likely to grow further as the per capita egg, milk production in Jharkhand is far below than national average. Huge potential in meat production and processing exist in the state. Other investment opportunities are

- Freezing and Frozen Units.
- Units for dried and canned fish
- Packaging and processing units
- Egg production unit
- Establishment of modern dairy & poultry farms
- Establishment of milk processing & cattle feed & fodder plant
- Cattle breeding centres
- Skill development program in dairy & poultry farming, meat production and processing
- Establishment of cold storage.
- Upgradation of existing cold storage
- Cold chain development for vegetable and horticulture produce
