India will resume the issuance of group tourist visas from October 15, 2021, and for individual tourists from November 15.

Foreign nationals intending to visit India for tourism purposes will be allowed to enter into India on an e-tourist visa/tourist Visa through chartered flights (for group tourism only) from October 15, 2021. All individual foreign nationals intending to travel to India for tourism purposes through any scheduled/non-scheduled commercial flights would be permitted to enter India from 15 November 2021.

All such desirous foreign nationals would be required to obtain a fresh e-tourist/regular visa from the Bureau of Immigration or the Indian Embassy through <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/>. These visas will be issued for 30 days with a single entry.

Existing valid e-tourist visas/Regular Tourist visas issued before October 15, 2021, will remain suspended.

First 5,00,000 tourist visas would be issued on a 'Gratis' basis and admissible only once per tourist.

Covid 19 protocol and guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India shall be strictly adhered to by the foreign nationals visiting India.
