Press Release: Visit of Hon'ble Justice Surya Kant, Supreme Court of India to Poland, 4-8 June 2023

The Hon'ble Justice Surya Kant, Judge of the Supreme Court of India, led a judicial delegation, consisting of Justices Sachin Datta and Amit Mahajan of the Delhi High Court, to meet with the judiciary of Poland, 4-8 June 2023. The delegation met with Justices Joanna Misztal-Konecka and Justice Aleksander Stępkowski of the Supreme Court of Poland. They visited the Constitutional Tribunal of Poland and held useful talks with a panel of judges there led by Justice Jaroslaw Wyrembak. Justice Surya Kant then had an interaction with the Faculty of Law of the University of Warsaw, co-hosted by the Dean Prof. Tomasz Giaro and Ms. Malgorzata Bonikowska, President of the Centre for International Relations.

The Justices met with members of the Indian community who attended the seminar. The Hon'ble Justice Surya Kant also inaugurated the premises of the Honorary Consulate of India in Wroclaw.


